There is only one possible start per discipline  
(kata, weapon, team forms, self defense, fighting)!

**Protective equipment: hand, foot, deep, teeth and head protection are mandatory!**

Referees and participants should show up in an appropriate clothing

## Rules

### General information:

After the category has been called out each starter has to go to the appropriate competition area and register in the starting list (full name in block letters). Before the start the whole group has to line up and welcomes the referees. Each starter has to wait until he received his rating – he then bows and goes back to the group. Once all the starters of one category received their rating, they will line up again and bow to the referees.

**Kumite and Self defense are always divided in male and female.  
Not so: forms - children up to max. 13 years and team forms.**

### Forms / weapon forms:

After calling the starter goes to his starting position, says the name of the form and begins!

Each starter is fully responsible for his weapon!

Note the german law (concerning weapons) – for example: NO NUNCHAKUS allowed!!!

### Self defense:

3 different attacks – three different techniques  
Attacks and partner may be freely chosen

### Fighting / Kumite:

First the head-referee is to be welcomed, next the starters will welcome each other. The fight will be started by the head-referee (in coordination with the time keepers).

Each referee is allowed to stop the fight as soon as he sees a hit or anything not allowed.

After stopping the fighters go back to the starting position. Immediately the head referee will ask for the ranking – the linesmen will raise the red or the white flag while the head referee will show the left or right hand.

The required number of points for a win will be decided / announced at the day of the tournament. THE FIGHT WILL BE 2 MINUTES. ONLY CLEAR HITS ARE SCORED!

Head – for all: Top of head, forehead, side of head - face only hit from red / brown / black belt!

Body for all: side and front of the body from the waist / belt up

Forbidden zones: throat, neck, back, body below the belt and legs

**ALL TECHNIQUES ARE ALLOWED ONLY WHEN BEING CONTROLLED AND AS SEMI CONTACT (POINTFIGHTING)!!!**
